

Also click on "more" then "Setup" and select which categories you would like to receive Alerts for.

For those that have Android phones, simply search our school "Good Shepherd School Plumpton" and install. After the app is installed click on "more" then "Setup" and select which categories you would like to receive Alerts for.

School Fees - Term 2

Catholic Education sent out school fee accounts for Term 2 during the last couple of weeks. **These fees are due by 4th June** if you do not have an arrangement in place with Mrs Carr. Families on arrangements would have received a statement last week. Please check your statement to ensure your payments are being paid as per your agreement.

Grooming and Jewellery

The following expectations apply to students at Good Shepherd. Hair is a very important aspect of your child's appearance. Children must have appropriate hair cuts. Coloured hair is not permitted, nor should hair be cut in steps or stairs, or have any other symbols or patterns. Long hair needs to be tied back. Green or white ribbons or scrunchies are permitted. No rat's tails or mohawks are permitted. Jewellery is only one plain sleeper or stud to be worn in each lobe. No other earrings are permitted. One signet ring is permitted and a cross and chain or other symbols of our faith are permitted. Any other jewellery is not permitted, nor is makeup of any description. Parents are asked to please ensure that children attend school in accordance with uniform expectations.

Visas

Parents, could you please ensure that the school has the most up-to-date paperwork on your child's Visa status ie if his/her status has changed, if your child is now an Australian citizen or his/her passport has expired and a new one has been reissued. Thank you.

Before and After School Expectations Morning Supervision

Children who are on site between 8:00 am and 8:10 am must be seated in the undercover area. Supervision will begin at 8:10 am. No child should be at school before this

Afternoon Supervision

All children are required to be picked up by 3:15 pm each day.

Supervision finishes at this time as staff are then required to fulfil their out-of-class hours duties.

Those children who remain at school after this time will be sent to COHSC and charged accordingly.
