Sacramental Programme for 2015/2016 Good Shepherd Parish Plumpton

Enrolment forms for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are now available at Good Shepherd Church. Children who are seven years old or older are eligible for enrolment in these sacraments. Forms are to be returned on enrolment day (Sunday 1st November 10.30 am in the Parish Hall [Bingo]) along with a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate. Classes will commence on Sunday 8th November and continue each Sunday (at 10.30 am) until Sunday 29th November. Children will make their First Reconciliation this year following completion of the four lessons. First Holy Communion will then take place early in 2016.


Which fish is second from the bottom?



Free "Alerts" and more to your mobile phone

Did you know that you can receive "Alerts" to your mobile phone for free? This is very handy to have and will keep you updated on "last minute" changes or reminders to School events. The App is called "Skoolbag" and to install this free App on your IPhone or Android phone, this is what you do: Simply search for Good Shepherd School Plumpton in the App Store on your phone, PC or Mac and install. After the App is installed on your phone, make sure that you select "OK" to allow Alert notifications. Also click on "more" then "Setup" and select which categories you would like to receive Alerts for.
