
Dear Parents and Guardians,

### Change of School Bus Numbers (Busways)

Dear Parents & Carers, please note that the bus numbers of Busways trips serving your school will change, commencing on Monday 2nd November, 2015. This is due to Transport for NSW business Rules that necessitate all bus companies to convert dedicated school buses to an individual 4 digit number, in order to assist with reporting and technology requirements. As a result, the existing 1 and/or 2 digit numbers will need to change – for a general example, Bus 1 becomes 6015. It is important to note that there are no changes to the roads used and arrival/departure times associated with this process – it is just a simple renumbering of the existing Busways services at your school. We also wish to highlight that any 'route' services (generally a 3 digit number) which serve your school will not change. Attached to this newsletter, is the Busways Flyer.

Whooping cough information for schools

There is an outbreak of whooping cough (pertussis) in NSW, mainly affecting schoolaged children.

Coughing spreads the infection to others nearby. Whooping cough can spread to anyone at home, including younger brothers and sisters. Whooping cough can be especially dangerous for babies.

Whooping cough starts like a cold and progresses to bouts of coughing that can last for many weeks. The infection can occur even in fully-vaccinated children. Older children may just have a cough that is persistent and may be worse at night.

- Children with these symptoms should see a doctor.
- If your doctor diagnoses whooping cough in your school-aged child, please let the school know and keep your child at home until they have taken 5 days of antibiotics. Keep coughing children away from babies.
- Whooping cough vaccines give good protection against infection but immunity fades with time. Check that all your children are up to date with their vaccines, due at 6 weeks, 4 months, 6 months, 4 years and 12 years of age (offered to all Year 7 students through the NSW school-based vaccination program). A booster is also recommended at 18 months of age.

A booster dose of vaccine is also recommended for adults that are in contact with young children, such as school staff and parents. Pregnant women are recommended to have a booster dose during each pregnancy and this is funded by NSW Health. Those who are new parents or carers of babies should consult their general practitioner about appropriate immunisation.

if you lived in a wildly windy place, what would the land and the plants look like? What about if you lived in a rainforest, a hot desert, or a cold one? Would there be lots of trees or none? Would there be food for animals and places for them to sleep?

Create a graphic design, ceramic work, painting, drawing, collage, relief or sculpture that tells a story about climate. It can be a real climate you have experienced or one you have imagined.

Finalists are exhibited alongside the main exhibition from 5 December 2015 to 30 January 2016.

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

A parent or guardian must read the terms and conditions of this entry form carefully and sign the declaration for children submitting entries.

- Entrants are encouraged to address the theme of Climate: Let's Talk About the Weather
  in their work, however this is not compulsory.
- 2. There are no fees for entry. Works submitted will not be for sale.
- Blacktown Arts Centre on behalf of Blacktown City Council reserves the right to limit the display to a maximum of 150 works according to quality of work and space availability.
- 4. Entrants must live or attend a school within the Blacktown Local Government Area and be aged 5-15 years old on the 1 October 2015.
- 5. Entries:
- (a) Each child/young artist is limited to one (1) entry
- (b) Maximum size of works accepted:
- Two dimensional works A3 size (30cm x 42cm), not including frame
  - Three dimensional works 30cm x 30cm x 30cm
- (c) For two dimensional works, entrants are strongly encouraged to frame submitted work. This will allow professional presentation in the exhibition. Blacktown Arts Centre staff reserve the right to attach hanging devices where necessary
  - (d) Each entry must bear the fittle, medium and entrant's name, address, school, school year, age and phone contact details on the back (e) Each entry must be the original work of the entrant and must have been completed since

October 2014

- . Entrants will allow their work to be reproduced by Council and/or the media (with Council's permission) for art prize promotion, signage, website, catalogue entry and official Council-authored or supported reports only. Council also reserves the right to negotiate with entrants for the use of reproductions of their work for other purposes.
- 7. The decisions of the Judges and Blacktown Arts Centre on behalf of Council in all conditions of entry, display and judging will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. Collection of entries at the conclusion of the exhibition is from 10am 5pm Friday 5 and Saturday 6 February 2016. Works that are not collected will be held for one week after the arranged pick-up date but will thereafter be disposed of without further notice.
