Disability Parking

The school has one parking spot reserved for disabled parking. The spot is located in the Hyatts Road staff car park. This spot needs to remain clear at all times unless you possess an Australian Disability Parking Scheme permit issued by the Roads and Maritime Services. There have been several incidents reported whereby cars have been parked in the disabled spot without a permit displayed.

The Good Shepherd Church car park also has a number of disabled parking spots and this law applies to the Church and anywhere a disabled parking spot is located.

Heavy fines apply for stopping in spaces reserved for people with disabilities without a permit displayed. You can also incur a fine if you have a permit but do not display it on the vehicle when stopping or parking in a reserved space.
