

Good Shepherd School Bag

As we are experiencing delays with regards to the delivery of the official School Bag, we have extended the time frame for students to be using the Good Shepherd School bag. From Term 1, 2019, all students (EXCEPT YEAR 6 2019) will be required to use the official Good Shepherd school bag. The decision to have these bags as a standard part of our school uniform was made in 2015, voted in by the school Leadership Team as well as the Parent Group. Upon receipt of the new schoolbags from the manufacturers we will notify you of the availability and price. Payment will be cash only. These bags are designed to evenly distribute weight and are made of extremely durable materials making them good value in the long run. Thank you
