Parent Data Validation Survey

Having accurate, up-to-date information on our students is an important part of maintaining their safety and wellbeing, and supporting their learning. It also assists schools to make good decisions about how best to support and care for all students. To ensure that the data we currently hold is current and accurate, CEDP is conducting a data validation survey.

What does this involve?

It is pretty straight forward. Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) will send you an email, SMS and/or letter with a link to the survey. Please note that in some cases you may need to confirm visa details, arrival and school starting dates in Australia, so please have this information with you before starting the survey.

The survey will ask you to confirm or change the information the school currently has about your child/children. This could include names, addresses, email addresses etc. In the majority of cases, the information will not have changed. If it has, it is important you record this in the survey. Letters sent to parents will include instructions on how to access the survey online.

Completing this survey helps to ensure that we have the right information about your child in the case of an emergency and for programs that best suit your child's needs.

Reminder emails and SMS will also be sent.

Registration must be completed by Thursday 7th

February 2019. Please ensure that all sections are filled out appropriately including 'Rep experience' where applicable. These trials are generally for those children who display an above average ability in their chosen sport. While teams are open in age it is strongly recommended that only children of a representative standard in Years 5 & 6 in 2019 be invited to attend.

Students must attend the selection trials to be eligible for selection.

Selections will be made based on performance at the trial. Selectors will be appointed based on their experience and background in a particular sport.

Please note that this online registration is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ONLY** and MUST be approved by your child's school principal. This will occur after the closing date whereby schools will be emailed their school nominations. Notification to the students will be via the school sports coordinator after the closing date.

The final selection of students to attend the respective sport Diocesan team sport trials is based on the Representative Experience and/or Playing History of the student by the school principal and sports coordinator.

Parents are responsible for organising their child's transport to and from their respective sport trial and their child's supervision at the trial.

If nominating for more than one sport, a new form must be completed for each sport.

Student Supervision

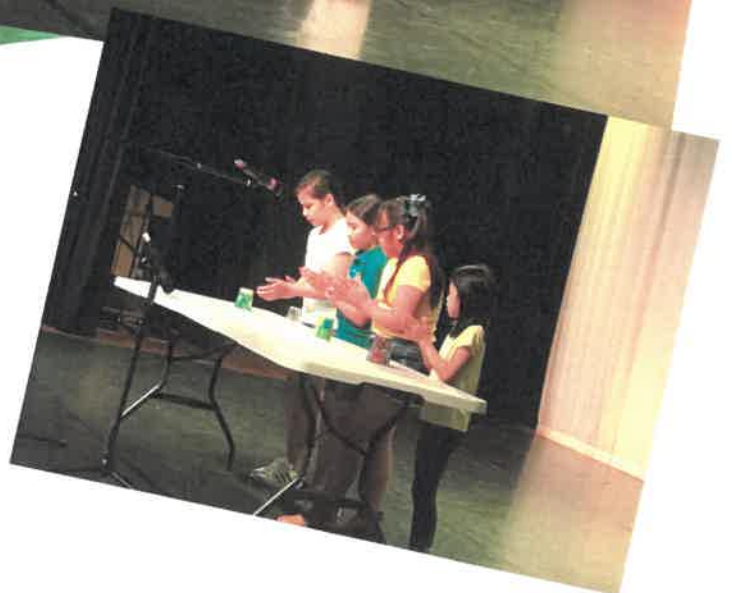

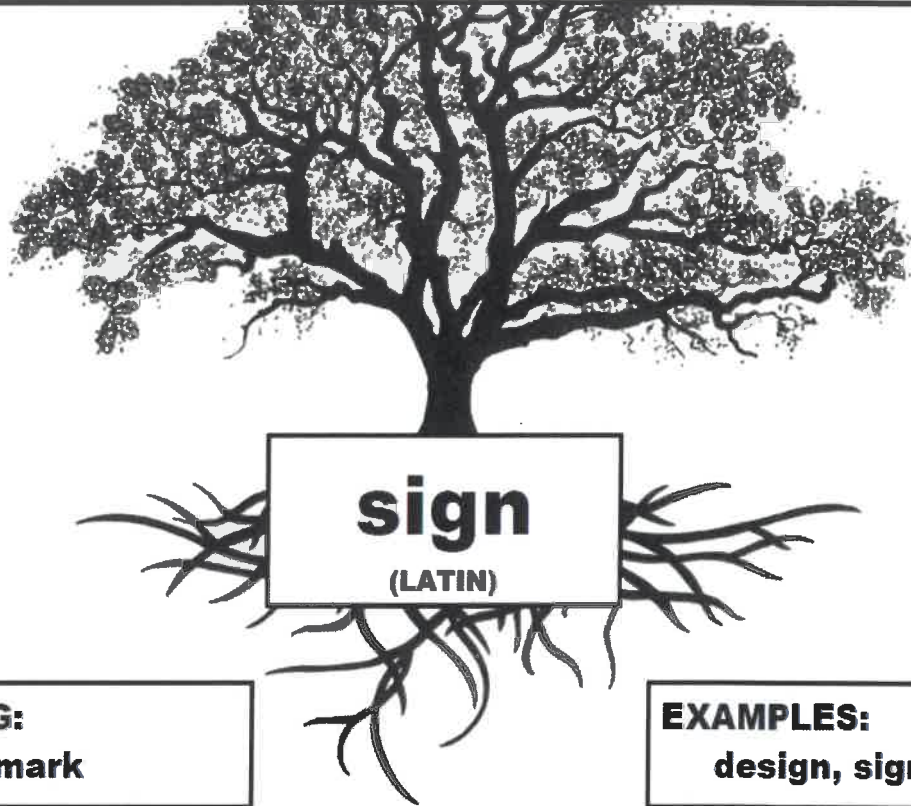

Number Activity:

Back to zero: Players begin at 30, 50 or 100 on the numberline/ tape measurer. Take turns rolling the dice and predict what number the pegs will land on. Prove their thinking by moving the peg the number of places rolled on the die. Record the number sentences to show thinking.

Purpose:

A race from a two digit number back to zero. This is a fun subtraction activity that focuses on mental strategies using a numberline as a guide.

Resources:

A dice

Two different coloured pegs

Number line or a tape measure

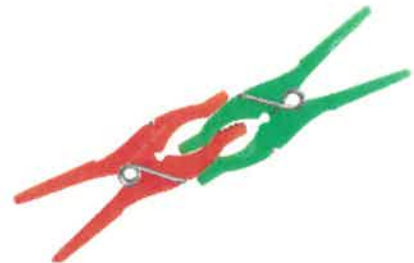
Possible Questions:

SWIMMING CARNIVAL FRIDAY DEC.14TH 2018

Dear Parents,

The Good Shepherd Swimming Carnival will be held Friday 14th December this year – Week 9.

At this carnival, to be held at Mt. Druitt Swimming Pool, children from Yr.3-Yr.5 will have the opportunity to swim 100m Freestyle and 50m Freestyle, Backstroke, Butterfly and Breaststroke in their age group (the age they turn this year) 7yrs, 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs and 11yrs. Yr.6 will swim their own races as they do not qualify for Zone next year.

The best swimmers in these events, **based on their times** swum will qualify to swim at the Blacktown Zone Swimming Carnival to be held Thursday 14th February 2019. The age groups for 2019 will be 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs and 12yrs in 50m Freestyle and Junior, 11yrs and Senior for Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly. There are qualifying times for all zone events

Children from Yr.3-6 will also be able to swim 25m races in each of the strokes. Novelty events will be held in the 25m shallow pool for those swimmers unable to swim 25m or 50m. Please tick, on the next page, the events your child will enter.

All children should wear their swimming bathers to school, under their sports uniform. Please ensure your child/children have recess, lunch, hat, sunscreen, towel and underwear in a labelled bag. House (team) colours are permitted to be worn.

CLASSES WILL DEPART SCHOOL AT 8.40 AM BY BUS AND RETURN BY 2.30 PM. If your child is not returning to school after the carnival, please inform the teacher.

To ensure the carnival runs smoothly, it would be appreciated if you could assist by completing the attached page. Parents who wish to assist at the carnival must have completed "Building Child Safe Communities" registration and training module for verification.

While teams are open in age it is **strongly recommended that only children of a representative standard in years 5 & 6 in 2019 be invited to attend**. To facilitate this, Parramatta Diocesan trials will be held in the following sports:

To be eligible for selection for these trials an Online Team Registration Form must be completed that can be accessed via the website www.primarysportparra.catholic.edu.au ~ Click on "REP SELECTIONS" tab and scroll down to the **SPORT** you wish to register for and click on the "REGISTER" button below the heading "INFORMATION & REGISTRATION PROCESS". **Each sport has a different registration criteria**

This online form is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST** for the 2019 Parramatta Diocesan Primary Sport Team trials. You may complete this form to attend a selection trial or if you have been selected in a representative squad or team. One form is to be completed per child, per individual sport and when completed, click SUBMIT.

Please note that your online registration is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ONLY** and **MUST be approved by your child's school**. In order for your child to attend the nominated trial or event this may come down to the discretion of your school as to who is selected to attend the trial. In some sports only 2 students per school can be nominated. **Please complete all fields and especially "Representative Experience"**.

Your child's school will notify you one week prior to the trial date if your child is to attend to the Parramatta Diocesan trial for their selected sport by providing a trial information sheet.

Under no circumstances will a child be eligible to trial if the Online Registration Form has not been completed and approved by the school by the closing date.

All 2019 trial Fee - \$10.00 per sport - Once your child has been approved to attend the Parramatta Diocesan Trials, please make payment to your school prior to the trial.

Please note that the full day trials will be for boys cricket, boys soccer & boys rugby league. Due to the popularity of boys cricket, boys soccer and girls netball a maximum of 2 children only are eligible to trial from each school. Selection of the 2 boys and girls will be made jointly by the school sport coordinator and principal.

Half day trial for tennis, rugby and netball... all other trials will be held after school beginning at 4pm.

MACKILLOP TRIAL

It should be noted that the main purpose of the Mackillop trial is to select a team to compete at the NSW PSSA Championships. The Inter-Diocesan MacKillop Trial is not a competition although a round robin format is often used to facilitate the selection procedure.

NSW PSSA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Children who are successful at being selected in the Mackillop team will compete at the NSW PSSA Championships. These championships involve three or four days of competition at various locations in NSW. Children selected in these teams may also be required to attend training sessions. At the NSW PSSA Championships a State team will be selected to participate at the School Sport Australia Inter State Exchange for some sports.

SCHOOL SPORT AUSTRALIA

To be considered for selection in the NSW PSSA state team for participation at all School Sport Australia 12 Years & Under championships: Students must be turning between the ages of 10 and 12 in the year of competition i.e. Students turning the ages of 8, 9 and 13 in the year of competition are not eligible for NSW PSSA State selection. **The School Sport Australia Championships are held over numerous days that may include weekend.**

Please note the following information:

- The Diocesan trials, MacKillop trials and NSW PSSA Championships are held on school days.
- Parents are responsible for all transport and supervision arrangements and **must remain to supervise their child at the trial at all times.**
- Children need to generally be of representative standard.
- Attendance at training days, where applicable is compulsory.
- The selector's decisions are final.
- **Parents will need to make their own travel arrangements for children representing Parramatta at Inter-Diocesan MacKillop trials. This may mean travel to Sydney, Wollongong, Canberra, Wagga or Forbes.**
