Term 2 Learning Program

This term the children will be continuing to learn many interesting things:

In **Religious Education**, the children will study the units – Together, Stories of Jesus and Baptism.

In **English** the children will continue to develop their reading, writing and speaking and listening skills.

In **Mathematics**, they will learn about fractions and decimals, position, chance, length, time, multiplication and division, area and patterns and algebra.

In **HSIE - History**, they will continue to learn about Past and Present Family Life.

In **Personal Development, Health and Physical Education** they will learn about safe living. They will also develop some basic skills such as kicking, soccer and athletic skills.
